DAY 1: HANOI

Welcome to the modern day capital of Vietnam! Narrow streets and charming shops inside the old colonial quarter are best explored by a cyclo ride. Hoang Kiem Lake is but one of the many lakes in the city of Hanoi. Tree-lined boulevards, beautiful parks and many monuments are all snapshots showing a glimpse of the country's past and present times.... Upon arrival your driver will bring you to your hotel in Hanoi. Enjoy the remaining day and overnight in Hanoi.

DAY 2: HANOI

Start your full day Sightseeing Tour. The Temple of Literature, the One Pillar Pagoda, and the Old Quarter are just some of the highlights you will experience today! Overnight in Hanoi.

DAY 3: HALONG

Drive to Halong Bay to enjoy a 4 hours boat excursion on board a traditional Vietnamese junk. Cruise among the emerald waters and craggy limestone cliffs of Halong Bay, stopping to explore one of the many caves in this area. Lunch will be served on board. Overnight in Halong.

DAY 4: HOI AN

Drive to Hanoi Airport to embark your flight to

Danang and proceed to the picturesque town of Hoi An. Overnight in Hoi An.

DAY 5: HUE

Hoi An is a quaint and beautifully preserved historic city which is best seen on foot. Known as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, enjoy a walking tour through the ancient town and visit the Japanese Covered Bridge Pagoda, Sa Huynh Museum, the Tran Family Chapel, the Phuoc Kien Assembly Hall and the Lantern-Making Workshop. After your half day Sightseeing tour through Hoi An you will drive to Hue and stop en route to visit the Marble Mountains and China Beach. Pass the fabulous Hai Van Pass and enjoy one of the most spectacular views of the coastline! Overnight in Hue.

DAY 6: HUE

Embark on a local boat and cruise down the Perfume River to the iconic Thien Mu Pagoda. Afterwards discover the Imperial Tomb of the Emperor Tu Duc and go back to history by visiting the imperial city of Hue. End your tour with a visit of the famous Dong Ba market. Overnight in Hue.

DAY 7: SAIGON

Take your morning flight to the bustling city

of Saigon. Start your discovery tour in South Vietnam with an excursion to the incredible Cu Chi Tunnels, a former underground network during the Vietnam War. Overnight in Saigon.

DAY 8: SAIGON

A vibrant metropolis, Saigon teems with energy, activity and motion. Everywhere you look, you see the meeting of traditional and modern customs. Begin your full day tour by strolling along Dong Khoi Street, where all the high-end international branded shops are located. Continue onwards and visit the remaining remnants of European-style architectural designs applied to the City Hall (Hotel De Ville), and the old Opera House. Finally, pay a quick visit to the neo-romanesque Notre Dame Cathedral and the Central Post Office. Afterwards dive into modern history with a tour of the Reunification Palace. Continue to the harrowing War Remnants Museum and visit Emperor Of Jade Pagoda, one of Saigon's most interesting pagodas. In the afternoon, head out to Cholon (Chinatown) and end your tour at the central Ben Thanh Market. Overnight in Saigon.

DAY 9: SAIGON

It's time to say goodbye! Your driver will transfer you to the airport.
